

ESL Endorsement for Certified Teachers

- ❖ 20-credit planned program which qualifies teachers for professional certification
- ❖ The entire program can be completed in one year (fall through summer semesters)
- ❖ Winter and summer S01 courses are on-line (10 credits)
- ❖ All courses can count toward Oakland University's Master of Arts in Linguistics.
- ❖ ESL Endorsement increases a teacher's job opportunities
